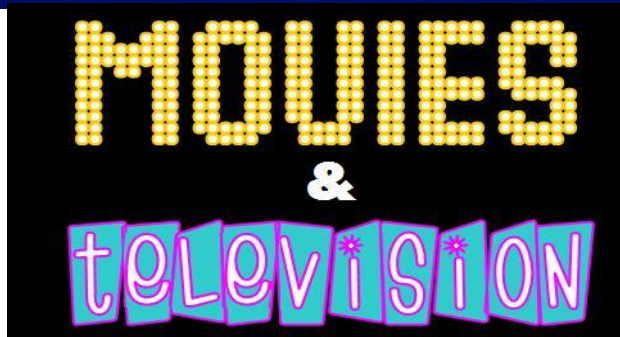

Recipes:

Raspberry and Coconut Cupcakes

Ingredients:

6 oz self raising flour

6 oz butter

6 oz caster sugar

2 eggs

2-3 oz desiccated coconut

2-3 oz fresh/frozen raspberries

icing(optional):

4-6 oz icing sugar

4-6 oz butter

Desiccated coconut (as much as you would like)

raspberries(as much as you like)

Method:

. set oven to 160 degrees

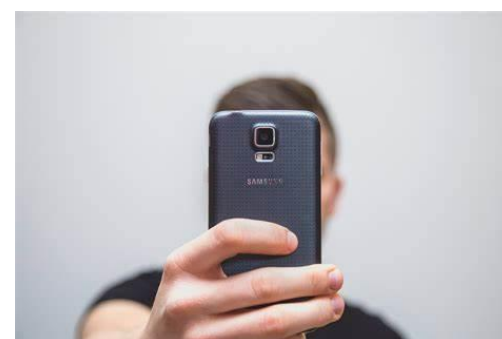
. mix butter and sugar together
