YEAR 8 & 9 ONLY

Cost: £988

This is a 5 day/ 4 night RESIDENTIAL

Group Leader: Mr Hallett (Geography)

Venue: Reykjavik

Places: 40

Year Groups: Years 8 & 9 ONLY

Details of Activity:

This is a fully guided tour to Iceland including coach transfer and flights, staying in a hotel in the capital Reykjavik on a full board basis. Students travel from THS to Iceland on Sunday evening 16th July for a Monday morning flight, via Luton Airport with EasyJet or Icelandair (TBC nearer the time). Each day will involve coach trips around Iceland, taking in the amazing geography and geology of the island. This will include visiting the world-famous Geyser, Gullfoss, Europe's most powerful waterfall, a walk between two tectonic plates and hopefully a visit to an active volcano. There will also be an opportunity to visit the capital to buy some souvenirs of the trip. On Thursday 20th July students will travel by plane and coach to return to Tiverton late that evening.

Student Requirements:

Students will need to be prepared for plenty of walking, although coach travel will be provided to transport the group around Iceland to the various sites. They will need to come prepared for all weathers, as July in Iceland can be beautifully warm and sunny or cold and wet. Therefore, essentials include waterproof jacket and trousers and waterproof walking boots/wellies. A valid passport and visa (if applicable) and a suitable amount of Icelandic Krona for spending money.

This is a once in a lifetime experience that we are very excited to be able to offer to students. It will be particularly suitable for those taking GCSE Geography, as it will bring to life so much of what students study.

In order to secure the trip with the tour operator, we require a minimum of 30 students to pay an initial deposit of £230 by Monday 31st October 2022, please note this is an earlier deposit deadline to other residentials. The tour operator requires a further £70 to be paid by 31st December 2022.

If you would like your child to take part, please email <u>aw@tiverton.devon.sch.uk</u> stating the child's name and request to go on the Iceland residential. The deposit will then be set up on the School Gateway, or alternately bring cash or cheque (made payable to DCC) to the account's office on Monday 31st October. The final balance must be paid by the 31st May 2023.

Please note, by paying the deposit does not guarantee your child's place. You are still required to complete the electronic choices form, selecting Iceland as your first choice, along with a second and third choice, so we can allocate another activity should you be unsuccessful. The deposit will be refunded or transferred to another trip available for Activities Week.

GERMANY, RHINELAND

YEARS 7, 8 & 9

This is a 5 day/ 4 night RESIDENTIAL

Venue: Cologne Places: 50

Year Groups: Years 7, 8 & 9

Details of Activity:

This is an exciting opportunity to explore the landscape and culture of this part of Germany as well as test out your language skills. We will leave Sunday 16th July, travelling overnight by coach & Eurotunnel across Belgium to Cologne in the Northwest of Germany. This cultural capital is a fantastic place to have as our base, staying on a half board basis in the Jugendherberge Köln-Riehl Cologne Youth Hostel, just 100m from the banks of the river Rhine. Whilst here we will explore Cologne Cathedral, Cochem Castle and the Lindt chocolate factory. We will also travel a bit further afield to Boppard to visit the famous Deutsches Eck, the point where the Moselle & Rhine rivers meet. One of our day trips will include a visit to Phantasialand theme park where we can all let off some steam before embarking on our journey home, returning to Tiverton late on Thursday evening. Breakfast and dinner are included in the price, but you will need a suitable amount of spending money in Euros for lunch each day and souvenirs.

Student Requirements:

Students will need to be prepared for some walking, to be interested and engaged with the activities provided and to be able to follow instructions quickly. We will be travelling as a large group, so we will need you to be sensible, mature and trustworthy. You will need to be open to trying lots of different types of food and drink, as we have no control over the menu at the youth hostel, but I can assure you there will be plenty of choice, especially at breakfast! A valid passport and visa (if applicable), a new UK Global Health Insurance Card - GHIC will be required.

4 DAY LONDON

YEARS 8 & 9 ONLY

Details of Activity:

Students will be able to explore the sights of our capital! With 3 nights in a hotel (Premier Inn London Hayes, Heathrow) and food from local eateries; potentially Pizza Express, Bella Italia and Las Iguanas. Packed lunch will also be provided for Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. There will be a tour of the major sights including a visit to the Natural History Museum and the Science Museum. Also included is the London Bridge Experience...... be prepared to be scared! There will be an opportunity to view London from on high with time on the London Eye. Students will also visit a top West End show, to be confirmed nearer the time, plus a FULL day at Thorpe Park. Fast Track passes may be available to purchase nearer the time. These are not compulsory but it's something you may wish to consider. The prices haven't been launched for next summer but this year the costs were; Exhilarate £35, Adrenaline £45, Unlimited £100, or one-shots are typically £10. Details of Activity:

The students will travel to North Cornwall on Monday 17th July returning on Thursday 20th. This is an adventure-packed residential trip to beautiful North Cornwall. Five lengthy sessions including activities ranging from surfing, stand-up paddleboarding (SUP), kayaking to coasteering – all of which take place in and around Harlyn Bay. Our full-board accommodation is a short drive away at the amazingly located YHA overlooking Treyarnon Bay. The final morning will be a visit to the heart of the UK surf scene, Newquay.

Student Requirements:

Students will need to be able to swim. Students will also need appropriate footwear for coasteering, old trainers, wetsuit boots, reef shoes etc. Wetsuits are provided.

SNOWDONIA ADVENTURE

YEARS 7. 8 & 9

This is a 5 day/ 4 night RESIDENTIAL

Details of Activities:

Do you have the determination to make it to the top of one of Britain's highest peaks? Are you brave enough to climb a sheer rock face? Could you face the cold to scale through the thundering water of a gorge, and jumping into rock pools? Or move through underground mines with only a torch for light? Then this adventure filled trip could be for you! This residential will give students the opportunity to experience some extreme activities in the stunning mountains of Snowdonia. Students will travel to Snowdonia by THS minibus on Sunday 16th July and return on Thursday 20th July. Students will participate in a variety of activities during the week, designed to be action-packed and challenging. Activities will include a full mountain day where students will walk/scramble to the top of one of the UK's highest peaks. Other activities could include gorge scrambling, rock climbing, underground mine exploration and kayaking. Activities may slightly alter to cater for the needs of the group and will all be led by qualified and experienced instructors. Accommodation will be in dormitory rooms and breakfast and dinner will be prepared for you. Packed lunches will be provided for day time activities.

Student requirements:

Students should be prepared to challenge themselves physically and emotionally in a variety of outdoor adventurous activities in any weather! This means that a waterproof jacket and bottoms and walking boots suitable for walking on the mountains will be needed, along with clothing and footwear that will get wet. To get the most out of the trip students will need to participate in a training walk (or join in with the DofE or Ten Tors training). Students need to be prepared to travel by minibus and to sleep in dormitory style rooms.

Details of Activity:

Do you enjoy cooking, baking and eating? Are you interested in eco-cooking and sustainable farming? Then why not try our fun food week. Students will spend three days learning different cooking techniques, making a range of dishes to eat on each day. On Wednesday we will visit Magdalen Farm in Chard, set in a 132-acre organic working farm on the banks of the River Axe. Hands on Farming — students will have the opportunity to work together providing assistance with important jobs around the farm. Eco-cooking - Students will be able to pick their own fresh ingredients from the farm's kitchen gardens and either cook delicious pizzas using their outdoor cob ovens or make pedal powered smoothies on their blender bikes.

All ingredients are included in the cost of the 4 day package.

Student Requirements:

Students will need to wear sensible shoes and lightweight clothing, as the cooking classrooms have potential to get hot when all ovens are on! Clothes may get flour etc. on them. For our visit to the farm, students will need to wear old clothes and wear wellington boots or old trainers.

Details of Activity:

If you enjoy the outdoors and are interested in learning survival skills, team building and living on the wild side, then this package is for you! Students will spend three days onsite at THS learning new practical skills each day, which will equip them for the final day's survival challenge offsite. Using the skills they have learnt, students will work as a team to make a camp in the woods, light a fire, make water safe and cook themselves lunch. A prize will be awarded for the best camp! All resources are included in the cost of the 4 day package.

Monday 17th July – Team building onsite to include a session of archery.

Tuesday 18th July – Fire building & management onsite to include knife safety.

Wednesday 19th July – Shelter building onsite to include survival in the wild.

Thursday 20th July – Survival Challenge offsite at local walks to include searching for deer.

Student Requirements:

Students will need to show a responsible attitude at all times. Full training of the safety procedures will be provided, and students must demonstrate an awareness of and follow these at all times. Students will need to wear old clothing. Due to the danger of sparks which make holes in modern synthetic materials we recommend clothes that are made of cotton or wool. Good strong footwear, walking boots or old trainers.

Details of Activity:

The THS Art team are running an exciting activity that will include a trip to the Eden Project in Cornwall on Monday and a trip to the RAMM Museum and Gallery in Exeter on Tuesday. This will be followed by two and a half days in the Art Department, designing and creating a large acrylic painting on canvas inspired by something that you have seen on the trips out. The Art team will give you lots of expert advice so that you can make something worth putting on your bedroom wall! This package will appeal to all of you creative students who fancy an adventure!

Student Requirements:

Students will need to wear suitable clothing for the activities described and for the weather conditions on the trip to the Eden Project. Students will need to have a sketchbook, phone or camera for taking pictures and basic drawing materials, these can be provided if needed.

This 4 day package is based in school and involves a variety of different craft workshops. Students will spend 3 days creating and crafting items to sell, as well as planning, promoting, advertising and budgeting our very own THS mini craft fair. The craft fair will take place on the final day and will involve setting up and selling the items made on days 1-3 to parents/carers coming to watch The Lion King performance.
